DIGGING DEEPER

True Belief

John 3:11-18 (Jesus is speaking.)

- 11 "I tell you the truth, we speak of what we know, and we testify to what we have seen, but still you people do not accept our testimony.
- 12 I have spoken to you of earthly things and you do not believe; how then will you believe if I speak of heavenly things?
- 13 No one has ever gone into heaven except the one who came from heaven—the Son of Man.
- 14 Just as Moses lifted up the snake in the desert, so the Son of Man must be lifted up,
- 15 that everyone who believes in him may have eternal life.
- 16 For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.
- 17 For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him.
- 18 Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because he has not believed in the name of God's one and only Son."
