

Romans 6:20-23

- ²⁰ When you were slaves to sin, you were free from the control of righteousness.
- ²¹ What benefit did you reap at that time from the things you are now ashamed of? Those things result in death!
- ²² But now that you have been set free from sin and have become slaves of God, the benefit you reap leads to holiness, and the result is eternal life.
- ²³ For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Titus 3:3-7

- ³ At one time we too were foolish, disobedient, deceived and enslaved by all kinds of passions and pleasures. We lived in malice and envy, being hated and hating one another.
- ⁴ But when the kindness and love of God our Savior appeared,
- ⁵ he saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit,
- ⁶ whom he poured out on us generously through Jesus Christ our Savior,
- ⁷ so that, having been justified by his grace, we might become heirs having the hope of eternal life.
